Following the 2023 International conference in Axiomatic Design (ICAD) in Eindhoven, the Netherlands, the UK will host the next ICAD conference in Cardiff at the Welsh School of Architecture on 25-27 June 2025.

The ICAD series is the traditional meeting point for the worldwide Axiomatic Design Community, including the Axiomatic Design Research Foundation (ADRF) and the *International Association for Axiomatic Design* (IAAD), since 2000. Since its first edition, ICAD conferences have been held in Cambridge and Worcester (MA-USA), Seoul and Daejeon (Korea), Lisbon (Portugal), Florence (Italy), Xi'an (China), Iasi (Romania), Reykjavik (Iceland), Sydney (Australia), Lisbon (Portugal), and Eindhoven (the Netherlands).

Axiomatic Design (AD) is a powerful design methodology developed by Professor Nam P. Suh that can be applied to the design of products, processes, and systems. AD is a Systems Design Method to systematically analyse and translate stakeholders needs into functional requirements, design parameters and process variables and support decision making while recording process information. Its structure provides a robust basis to support design innovation towards achieving the objectives set in the United Nations Agenda for sustainable development 2015-2030.
